

## Good Neighbour Policy

Welcome to Hucks Marine & Resort! We are delighted you have decided to spend some time with us! We encourage you to explore our Marina and enjoy all that our facilities, and surrounding area, have to offer.

Here at the Marina, we promote a Good Neighbour Policy. While with us, we ask that you conduct yourself with consideration for, and courtesy toward, other boaters and guests. We want everyone who visits us to feel comfortable and safe, so we do not tolerate behavior that is disorderly, disruptive or ill-mannered.

Please do not forget that, while we have set out some Good Neighbour guidelines, you are still required to abide by all local, provincial and federal laws when it comes to your actions, including with respect to the consumption of alcohol or marijuana.

This document is intended to highlight a few ways you can be a good neighbor during your stay with us:

Alcohol: Please ensure your consumption of alcohol does not cause disruption to fellow visitors or boaters.

Noise: The Marina is a relatively small area, and boy, does sound carry! Please be considerate to your neighbours by keeping noise levels down during late night and early morning hours.

Smoking, Vaping and Marijuana: We are committed to providing our boaters and guests with a smoke-free environment, so please note that there is no smoking permitted within 30 metres of the fueling dock area, in any Marina building, or in or around any of the common areas (including the common walkways, parking lot, and recreation areas).

Wake Speed: Wakes can cause damage to people and property, so we ask, when you are operating a boat within Marina waters, to please proceed at no wake speed.

Animals; Pets: We know you love your dog, but, unfortunately, not everyone shares your adoration of Spot! When walking your pets on Marina grounds, please ensure you are always in control of them and that you pick up after them. Also, we ask that you be mindful that your pet's barking or noises do not disturb those around you.

Laundry: We ask that you do not hang laundry on the outside of your boat or on our docks.

Garbage; Recycling: To ensure we keep all garbage / recycling out of our beautiful waters and off of our docks, please place all of your garbage / recycling in one of the designated bins we have at the Marina.
